- 1) invest accumulated college fees into high interest account and use interest to establish scholarship beginning 2006-2007
- 2) 1000\$ of each year's college fee will go towards a scholarship, the amount can be increased depending on the need to use funds for other items
- 3) GSA will pay convocation fee for all graduating students
- 4) Portion of money will be invested at beginning of each year into scholarship fund
- 5) Remainder to be deposited into high-interest savings account for future development fund
- 6) Once levy/college fee cheques are received in mid-October, any surplus fees from the previous year are to be invested in either the scholarship or future development fund
- 7) Scholarships will be disbursed through graduate studies according to criteria decided upon by GSA
