# **MINUTES** of Trent Graduate Students' Association

Meeting date: Monday, June 27, 2011

### 2011/2012 Budget: Kristen Schultz

- Working on the budget, for a general idea we will have less money than last year (\$3,000 less) because the 2009/2010 GSA had leftover money which was carried over for the 2010/2011 GSA budget.
- -Have about \$21,000 for the budget: most for conference bursaries (\$7,500), Trail College cabinet (\$1,000), conference and group support (\$1,500), and Symons series (\$5,000).
- Last year's budget was also greater because the GSA was able to make money off of some events.
- Reductions to from last year's budget to meet our current available funds for this budget will be through reducing the microfilm budget and other small under used categories
- For specific details on the proposed budget a document will be posted

### **Trail College Cabinet**

- Who will be making the events and making the budget? James Lisowski will look into this to make sure there will be no overlap in events

## **Conference and Group Support Application**

- Childhood studies, presenters and forums. Symposium (October 27-28, 2011)
- Graduate studies will be heavily involved; total cost will be about \$5,000
- Requesting \$250

### International Survey: Agnès Pelletier

- Take home message:
- Most international students did not understand their specific health plan coverage or benefits
- -Students want to know how to do tax returns, or rental laws, transportation
- Socially: students don't know extracurricular things to do; they would like international events (specifically for them)
- Maybe have events more themed to international students
  - could have potlucks of food from their countries or an Algonquin camping trip (but would need to look into the risk management for events  $\rightarrow$  Megan Lloyst will look into it) or could have a ski trip maybe at Curby (could rent a school bus and driver to take students there).
