Equity Commissioner Update (Andressa proxy for Adam):

- fitness challenge update
 - o starting about two weeks from now
 - 8-week challenge
 - o MOTION: to charge \$20 per person for the fitness challenge
 - DISCUSSION: for one program or all three? \$20 gets you into all three
 - *Passes unanimously*
 - o Adam wants one person from GSA at each seminar because he won't be able to make all the meetings – keep that in mind
- Adam met with Active Minds pres.
 - o Art Gala – people can donate art – fundraising for mental health
 - o Musical presentation
 - Both events are also awareness-raising
 - o Wellness Symposium with Adam presenting w/Active Minds about mental health issues and grad students
- PACHREA – accessibility document – conferring with Andressa

CUPE Rep Update (Andrea):

- Conversation with NDP Education critic Teresa Armstrong
 - o Critic was 'affable'
 - o we should not expect help from that end re: university financing
 - o tuition freezes are their proposal but that only delays the problem
- Social Committee meeting Feb 7 @ 4:30 in Stewart House – please join!
- CUPE will still accept TA log sheets

Senator Update (Kyle):

- Conversation with NDP Education critic Teresa Armstrong
 - o Kyle had same impression as Andrea – not tons of support coming from that direction
 - o She didn't really know about Strategic Mandate
 - o not familiar with university structures
 - o willing to listen
- \$750 head tax on new international students
- new Masters programs for Trent: M.Ed. and M.A. in Arts Administration
 - o revenue-generating programs
 - o Kyle has a hundred-page doc you can read
 - o above and beyond Trent's grad funding from gov't
 - o negotiating tactic for getting more funding
 - o hoping to become funded spots with CUPE stipends but finance would rather have them be professional degrees with differential tuition
 - o will be a different kind of graduate student in the GSA
 - o M.Nursing bandied about but no real discussion
 - o Motion to write a report on our opinion and Kyle will send to Grad Studies committee
 - So we need to email Kyle our thoughts – by end of next week
 - *Motion passed*

VP Exec Update (Beth):

- incorporation documents sent to TD to show we are the only TGSA
 - o there will be cheques with new "TGSA" acronym
- WEBSITE: new and improved contact info updated
- Incorporation requires a logo – old logo fine – Sword will be the "T"
- ING account: being followed up on – probs a complaint being filed with ombudsman with ING – hope to be settled by end of April at the latest
- Deb and Doug want us to spend more money on events at Traill – geared towards professional dev'tment
 - o Kim and Adrian should contact Doug
- Spring AGM : proposal to increase student levy +\$10 = \$1500/term – could go towards conference and group support
 - o Kimi: right now there \$9000 in it
 - o Andrea: we need to advertise it sooner
 - o Jess could add to emails?

- STRAW POLL: paying \$10 more in fees?
 - We pay much less than most schools
 - Much less than TCSA
 - Has not been increased in 8 years
- McMaster Summitt:
 - Motion: to pay \$72 for 407 ETR and gas bill for McMaster summit reimbursement
 - *Passes unanimously*

Other Business:

- Liz:
 - Principal Advisory Committee Report
 - Revamping of college system going on
 - Traill students giving their opinion
 - PAC felt CPC document gave short shrift to grad students/Traill
 - PAC sending response straight to the provost
 - First year student survey – thinking of opening it up to all grad students
 - Motion to have a \$20 FreshCo prize for incentive to complete:
 - *Passes unanimously*
 - 2 weeks to complete survey
- Ayden:
 - Meeting w/Doug and Deb about garden
 - Vegetable gardening would have to be container gardening
 - all the plants on Traill are already native and all mulch is already recycled so . . . what are we doing?
 - Dead-ended on this idea
