

The duties of the President shall be:

- a. To ensure that the responsibilities of each Executive position portfolio and Board Member Commissioner are being met;
- b. To ensure all requirements and necessary documentation regarding the Not for Profit Incorporation of the TGSA remains in good standing;
- c. To do a short presentation to the incoming Executive on Robert's Rules of Order in May and to do a short presentation to the incoming Board on Robert's Rules of Order in September;
- d. To ensure that the Executive Officers receives Positive Space training, Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) training, Anti-Oppression Training at the start of their terms;
- e. To represent the TGSA at the Presidents' Group Meetings;
- f. To serve as an Official Guest on the Board of Governors;
- g. To be the designated signee of the University-TGSA Support Agreement (Appendix 4);
- h. Overseeing the Discipline and Impeachment process;
- i. To sit on the Emergency Planning Committee, the Heritage Committee, Athletics Advisory CASSC Subcommittee;
- j. To be proxy for the VP Internal Affairs on CASSC or VP Senate Representative on Senate when required;
- k. To sit on the TCSA Board of Directors Committee in a non-voting capacity;
- l. To chair meetings the TGSA Long-Term Planning Committee;
- m. To attend meetings with various University Administration personnel, as needed;
- n. To attend meetings with other Student Unions across Ontario, as requested;
- o. To serve as the public face of the TGSA when dealing with media.
