Addendum I

Executive Reports

Emma (President)

- Meeting with AVP Students
 - Addition of fees for graduate students (ancillary and levy)
 Trent Campus Safety (include TUEFRT and WalkHome) ancillary fee is not charged to graduate student
 - Of course, graduate students have access to these services —> we should be providing funding for the programs
 - Trent Nature Areas is another ancillary fee that can be added
 - The addition of an ancillary fee does not need to go to referendum
- Levy group fees
 - Levy groups that have been considered for graduate students to pay in to include: Arthur Newspaper, Trent Child Care, Trent International Student Association
 - In order to add levy fees they need to go to referendum and be voted on by the membership with a quorum of 15% —> Lesley and Lawrence are going to look into this
 - Although we are a levy group that is subject to the levy group by-laws set out by the lev council, we do have get a vote on the levy council because we are a graduate student group and the levy council is an undergraduate organization
- CASSC Meeting
 - If anyone has information about the events that took place at HOTT please share it with Student Affairs
 - Trent Mudder is this weekend (so is Pumpkinfest with Traill College
- Meeting with Dean of Graduate Studies (Craig Brunetti)
 - Craig had his meeting with Julie Davis
 - Graduate student space is on the wish-list
 - The budget cycle was moved up ~6 weeks for everyone at Trent University
 - This means I need to get the proposal for overtime fee reductions done for

November

- Interested to see what other schools are doing
- A report published by CFS in 2015 indicates that only two schools in Ontario have post-residency fees for graduate students (this has since changed, but not drastically)
- Meeting with Shelley Strain (Sustainability)
 - Trent is working on a new Sustainability plan
 - Offered our services to help educate graduate students about sustainable practices at Trent

- Work with Shelley to help achieve her goals of what a sustainable Trent looks like
- Fun events (Linda Kash AKA the Philly Cream Cheese Angel coming to do improv/comedy, partnering with Trent frat and the free-market etc.)
 - Any projects or ideas we have we can share!
- Food Services Meetings
 - Trent has the least expensive meal plan in Canada (although prices have gone up with inflation)
 - Chartwells contract is up April 2024
 - Although Trent and Chartwells work together to make changes every year to the menu and services they offer
- Research Policy Committee Meeting
 - Everything in the RPC is confidential, however there is significant room for graduate students to have a say on how things operate at Trent as far as research goes

Meeting with Lee Hays (Alumni Engagement)

- Alumni has a list of \sim 27,000 Trent graduates (both from their undergraduate and graduate degrees)
- They send out monthly electronic newsletters to alumni about things going on at Trent and to share news and alumni highlights
- We were interested in doing a spotlight with the TGSA to highlight graduate research happening at Trent and alumni that are doing related work

Sarah (VP Communications):

- Created graphics for our Pride Picnic, apparel ordering, and our Fall General Meeting
- Circulated graphics and announcements through our social media channels, and through mass emails to graduate students
- Co-organized the Pride Picnic

Will (VP Senate Report):

- Sent out first drafts of the TGSA Bylaws/Policies to all TGSA executives
- Attended the CASSC Meeting on Sept 21, 2022

Egan (VP Student Affairs):

Events

- Helped run the TGSA booth at orientation. Brought the baked goods from Black Honey
- Served alcohol at the Traill Carnival from the beer tent
- Ran Pride Picnic event, with pizza, button making, and hanging out at Traill
